Juror Bios



Erica Bonavida is a studio painter who works primarily in oils and encaustic paint. Born and raised in Oklahoma, she did not begin painting until she was a senior in high school. She briefly studied a variety of art forms at the Liceo Artisticoat the Instituto Superiore in Acqui Terme, Italy. Erica then commenced her studies at the University of Central Oklahoma were she completed bachelor degrees in painting and French. She both lived in and traveled throughout Europe, visiting the great museums and historic sites. These experiences heavily influence her current work that centers on fabric still lifes, where a correlation to the painting techniques of the Renaissance masters can be seen. She pairs individual fabrics and textures together based on personal, tactile, and experiential memories to create her imagery. These memories are composed and translated through visual textures, undulating forms, and distinct, limited color harmonies. A quest to perfect minute detail drives her work.



Stephen Kovash is an artist, teacher and owner and manager of Istvan Art Consulting and is a Commissioner with the Oklahoma City Arts Commission. Through Istvan Art, Kovash manages private art collections, curates art shows and installations, consults on major art purchases and teaches classes in the Business of Art. He has earned a bachelor degree in Political Science with an Art minor, a Master of Public Administration and a MBA in Arts Management (with honors). He is Past President of the Oklahoma Visual Arts Coalition and the Plaza District Association and has served on the Board of the Individual Artists of Oklahoma. Kovash also works as a volunteer with the Oklahoma State Arts Council as a grant reviewer. Kovash coordinates many arts and community development events in the Oklahoma City area including music and performance events, storytelling events and the annual OKC Spring Festival of the Arts.



Mike Wimmer was born in Muskogee, OK and received his BFA from the University of Oklahoma and had the opportunity to study with Don Punchatz at The Sketch Pad Studio in Arlington, TX. Mike Later completed his MFA at the University of Hartford in Hartford, CT. Mike currently serves as the Distinguished Visiting Artist at the School of Visual Arts at Oklahoma City University and is also the resident artist at the Skirvin in Oklahoma City where he is working on his "Will Work For" series. In addition to a few dozen paintings for the Oklahoma Capitol, he has recently published Abraham, a children's book and is currently working on Hamilton.




